Papers in English or Russian (5000 characters including spaces, preferably without tables, diagrams or illustrations), the annotation (100-200 words) and keywords should be sent to [histlab@gmail.com](mailto:histlab@gmail.com) till **1 of April 2017**. Recommended template is given [here](#) (only in Russian, not mandatory).

## Visa Information

If you need a visa to visit Russia, please fill and sign the [application form](#), assure the signature by a stamp of the organization where you work. Send the digital copy of this form (scan) and the digital copy of the first page of your passport to [histlab@gmail.com](mailto:histlab@gmail.com) till 9 of March 2017. These documents are required for registration of a formal invitation, which is necessary for visa to Russia.

The application form must be completed in English. Translation of the application form points see below:

1. Full name (as in passport)
2. Date and place of birth (country, exact place of birth)
3. Series and number of passport of a foreign citizen
4. Date of issue and expiry date of passport
5. Full home address
6. Place of work / study - full name and exact address
7. Position
8. Travel dates (to the Russian Federation)
9. Place of obtaining a Russian visa - country, city (where there is a Russian consulate)
10. Cities to visit in Russia
