"New concepts and technologies in interdisciplinary domains of  
history and culture"**

Call for Contributions

Dear Colleagues,

On October 27, 2022, the Perm State University will host **the International Symposium "New Concepts and Technologies in Interdisciplinary Domains of History and Culture"** as part of the Perm Scientific Forum ["Science and Global Challenges of the 21st Century"](#). The symposium is organized by the Faculty of History and Politics and the Center for Digital Humanities of the Perm University. It will be held in a hybrid format, and there is the possibility of making a presentation in person or online.

The purpose of the conference is to stimulate discussions about key concepts, methodological guidelines of modern knowledge in the Humanities, discussion of theoretical and applied aspects of the involvement of technology in the study of history and culture.

Conference topics include, but are not limited to:

- New methods in the interpretation of historical sources;
- Interdisciplinarity, transdisciplinarity, and polydisciplinarity of historical research: opportunities and limitations;
- Study of history and culture in the spatial dimension;
- Social communications: New theoretical models and research practices;
- Digital technologies in creative industries and public historical projects;
- Material turn in modern knowledge in the Humanities.

We invite researchers, teachers, employees of museum professionals, archivists, librarians, and other experts from cultural institutions, developers of information resources, and representatives of the IT industry to participate in the forum.

In 2022, symposium participants are invited to publish the papers in English limited with 7-15 pages (according to the template) in the collection of Springer publishers on the topic "Innovations and Technologies in Interdomain Application" in the book series ["Lecture Notes in Networks and Systems"](#) (indexed in Scopus ). Articles are accepted until 13:00 Moscow time on April 22, 2022. The

contribution for publication in the collection is charged with 20,000 rubles. All submissions will be double-blind peer-reviewed, checked for relevance and originality. Details about the publication of articles in the proceedings are published on the website of [the Perm Scientific Forum](#).

To participate in the conference, you need to fill out an electronic form (<https://forms.gle/UN8p4es5x3Pcrkfa8>).

Participants of the event also have the opportunity to publish papers in the conference proceedings indexed in the Russian citation index. The maximum length of the article in Russian or English is up to 20 thousand characters. The article should be sent along with the registration information, attaching it to the field of the electronic registration form before **June 1, 2022**. You can also send an application and articles to [histlab@gmail.com](mailto:histlab@gmail.com). In the application, you need to indicate information about yourself and affiliation (academic degree, place of work, position, telephone, email), the preferred form of presentation (in-person or virtual), the title of the presentation, and attached file with the article prepared according to the template.

The template for papers is provided by [the link](#) on the page with the information about the conference. All submitted articles are subject to mandatory peer review. The Program Committee reserves the right to reject submitted material. The results of the review will be circulated by September 15, 2022. The conference proceedings will be published before the conference and registered in the Russian Citation Index.

Participation in the conference is free of charge. Conference languages are Russian and English.

Travel expenses and other costs are not covered by the conference organizers.
